should be nearer the surface, only harrowed in; but that in a light, sandy, or gravelly soil, it may be covered deeper; and that in all cases it should be so worked with the soil that, if possible it may permeate and mingle with the whole, from the surface downward, as far as in that particular soil it is advisable that it should be sunk.

With regard to seed, it is manifest that that which are small, and which produce feeble plants, should be deposited near the surface; those of larger size, and producing powerful shoots, may be planted deeper; and then there is something in the nature of the seed itself to be observed, as well as in the condition of the soil.
