

PRACTICAL ABOLITIONISM.—A number of prominent Abolitionists from the east who are in attendance upon the Evangelical Abolitionist Convention, now in session in this city, are staying at the Richmond House. Amongst them are the Rev. Gen. R. Cheever, of New York. Yesterday, at dinner, a negro was discovered at the table, sitting at the left of Brother Cheever, while at his right sat a couple of Boston ladies. Some ladies at another part of the table called the attention of Mr. Tabor, one of the proprietors, to the fact, and expressed the very common feeling among persons not practical abolitionists, that it was not agreeable to sit at dinner in company with a negro. Mr. Tabor at once directed one of the black waiters to have the black removed, and it was done accordingly. The abolitionists, among whom the negro was sitting manifested great sympathy for the black, and demanded finally if the rules of the house banished him from the company of his friends and companions at the public table. Upon being informed that such was the case, they were constrained to acquiesce. In leaving the dinner-table, a Brown Abolitionist found the negro whispering in the hall, and, to soothe the deep remorse of his heart, put his arm around the black friend escorting him. This disgusting maneuver was performed in the presence of a considerable number of gentlemen, and excited nothing but respect for the individual who thus sought to advertise his political sentiments. How the negro came to be at the table could not be ascertained. Cheever occupied the head of the table, the negro the left, and the ladies his right—Chicago Times, 1859.
