

**Mr. POOL ON INTERNAL IMPROVEMENTS.**—In the Rutherford *Enquirer* we find the proceedings of a meeting which recently came off in that county in which C. T. N. Davis, Esq., made a speech from the report of which we extract the following:

"Mr. Davis then referred to Mr. Pool as an internal improvement man; and showed that he is much more reliable for our interest than Gov. Ellis; that Gov. E. had been in the East, and although a western man by birth, had used such language in his speeches as was calculated to drive Eastern men away from the support of our internal improvements. Gov. E. has compared the West to the horse-leech, which is ever crying, give, give; and to the grave which is ever saying, more, more; that the East was the goose which lays golden eggs for the sole benefit of the West. Mr. Pool voted for the amendment to the Wilmington, Charlotte and Rutherford Charter; and while he was doing so, Gov. Ellis declined from his high position as Chief Magistrate of North Carolina and went into the lobby of the Legislature and did his utmost to defeat the bill in aid of our road. This he (Mr. D.) stated upon the authority of our late worthy democratic Senator Dr. L. A. Mills, who was so disgusted with Gov. E.'s conduct that he said on his return from Raleigh last year, he would never vote for him again."

**THE BLACK REPUBLICANS AND MR. BELL.**—The Republican press at the North are down upon Mr. Bell on the slavery question, and declare that instead of being a "conservative," as he has been represented, he is "out and out" "slavery defender and extensionist." The *N. Y. Evening Post* has a long article on the subject, and denounces Mr. Bell in no measured terms, for the sentiment uttered in his speech on the compromise, that "the soundness of the constitution, that the flag of the Union, protects the citizen in the enjoyment of his rights of property of every description, recognized as such in any of the States, on every sea, and in every territory of the Union, cannot be questioned."


