

Some Novel Laws Proposed.
Novelty seems to be the order of the day in State Legislation. We cite a few examples:

The Kansas Legislature has been petitioned for a law authorizing the lynching of horse thieves.

A man in the Indiana Legislature proposes that the State shall investigate the relation of the groundhog to the weather.

A Wisconsin Assemblyman has introduced a humane bill that cows shall be milked twice a day except when milked by calves.

The Nebraska Legislature has before it a measure for the artificial production of rain-storms by means of explosives and artillery.

The Pennsylvania Legislature is considering an anti-treating bill, also, a bill to prevent epileptics from being persons under 16 years of age.

A bill before the Nevada Legislature makes it a misdemeanor for any woman to "wear a hat at any theatre of greater height than three inches."

The New Jersey Legislature is considering a bill which forbids, under heavy penalties, any employer asking an employee whether or not he belongs to a labor union.

A convention has been held in Pickens county, S. C., to form a White Republican party. If enough white men can be induced to join to fill all the federal offices, no great effort will be made to increase membership. That is a very convenient size for the republican party in a Southern State.—Rochester Times

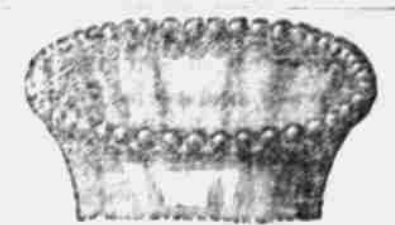
