My letter to Maj. Gen. Butler, herewith, is so full that I have but little to add...

While engaged in attacking the harbor of Vera Cruz, I regret, no less upon your account than my own, that you will not be in strength to manoeuvre offensively upon San Luis de Potosi...

I believe my arrangements of every sort, to be complete, except what everything depends on, my drawing from your command about 6000 regulars and volunteers...

With the greatest respect, I remain, truly yours, WINFIELD SCOTT.

Gen. Taylor's reply, dated Victoria, Jan. 15, 1847, says: Sir—In a communication addressed this day to your staff officer, I have replied to so much of your letter of the 6th inst...

The amount of force to be drawn from this frontier, and the manner in which it is proposed to withdraw it, had never fully come to my knowledge until yesterday...

I speak only of a defensive line; for the idea of assuming offensive operations in the direction of San Luis, by March, or even May, with such troops as can then be at my disposition...

I cannot misunderstand the object of the arrangements indicated in your letters. I feel that I have lost the confidence of the government...

I beg leave to remark, that the movement of the troops in this direction, and my own march hither, were undertaken for public reasons, freely set forth in my reports to the Adjutant General...
