SILVER AND THE PLATFORM

The following is the financial plank of the platform adopted by the National Democratic convention at Chicago, Ill. 1892:

We denounce the republican legislation known as the Sherman act of 1890, as a cowardly makeshift, fraught with possibilities of danger in the future, which should make all its supporters, as well as its author, anxious for its speedy repeal.

We hold to the use of both gold and silver as the standard money of the country, and to the coinage of both metals without discrimination against either metal, or charge for mintage, but the dollar unit of coinage of both metals must be of equal intrinsic value, or be adjusted through international agreement, or by such safeguards of legislation as shall insure the maintenance of the parity of the two metals and the equal power of every dollar at all times in the markets and in payments of debts; and we demand that all paper currency shall be kept at par with and redeemable in such coin.

Before the adoption of the platform Mr. Thomas M. Patterson, of Colorado, secured the floor and moved to amend the above by the insertion of the word FREE between the words 'the' and 'coinage' in the eighth line, so as to make the platform read:

NOT OPEN THUS:

As the Norfolk Public Ledger says, it is not often that the Republicans in the Senate get caught napping; but they were certainly badly outgeneraled last week when the Bland-Blaine bill was before that body for action.

As soon as Senator Hoar was made aware of the fact that he had been caught napping he made frantic efforts to repair the mischief that had been done, and was assisted by Mr. Sherman, the wily Senator from Ohio, but the friends of the bill, knowing the advantage that they had gained, refused to accede to the requests of the opponents of the measure, to the great discomfort of the latter, who would probably have talked a couple of weeks before they would have permitted a vote to be taken.

In consequence of the great political changes that have taken place in the country since the Presidential election of 1892, as disclosed by several State elections last Fall and numerous local elections more recently in the State of New York, the political contests of the year will be watched with more than ordinary interest.

Governors on the following dates: Oregon, June 4th, Alabama, August 6th, Arkansas, September 3d; Vermont, September 10th, and Georgia October 31. Nineteen other States will elect Governors in November, at which time Representatives will be chosen for the Fifty-fourth Congress of the United States.

The tariff bill which passed the Democratic House by sixty-two majority, has had rough usage in the Democratic Senate. Unfortunately for the country and the party, there are, in that body, several Democrats who styled themselves 'conservatives' on the tariff question.

Both real and iron have been taken from the free list, and a duty is placed on coke. A strong effort was made to take wool and lumber off the free list, but fortunately it failed.

The Senate committee increased a number of internal revenue taxes. The tax on whiskey was raised from ninety cents to one dollar by the House, but the Senate committee has added another ten cents. The tax is to apply, too, to all the whiskey in bond.
