ONE BUNDRED YEARS OLD.

Bishop Fallows says every person in this age of germs and hygiene should live to be a centenarian at least. Like all seers, the learned bishop has a fad. His is sour milk. His plan for prolonging life is not, however, novel. The Scandinavians drink sour milk as Americans drink lemonade. Sour milk is a luxury and a delight to the Scandinavian palate. They are not all centenarians but it must be admitted that they are inclined to be long-lived. Sour milk is eagerly sought in Persia, Armenia, Thibet and among other Asiatic peoples, but they rarely get enough of it, and so perhaps their lives are cut short.

We may be working toward a period when the average life will be 100 years long, but neither this generation nor several succeeding ones will see that time. And when it comes it will be found that it was the result, not of sour milk, but of improvement all along the line. The germs that render milk sour may be desirable, but they are not efficient enough to make the average individual a centennarian.

After all, it does not so much mattar. Each person thinks he is going to live to be 100 years old, anyway, and so long as we think so we get out of life all possible happiness without any sour milk accompanement. Bishop Fallows' panacea is not appetizing enough to become popular when everybody thinks he is going to celebrate at least one centennary birthday.

A DO-NOTHING CONGRESS.

If Congress adjourns today, thethings it has not done would fill a book. I has not revised the tariff to begin with. It has not attempted to put an end to the purchase of elections by passing a eampaign publicity bill. This is enough. We must not go on down through the list of its acts of omission.

What it has done consists almost altogether in earning the title of a billiondollar session, the first in the history of the country. The appropriation bills are not quite complete, but it is known that they reach the unprecedented aggregate of \$1,026,000,000 as follows: Sundry civil, \$120,000,000; legislative, executive and judicial, \$33,000,000; army, \$95.382,000; postoffice, \$221,765,000; pensions, \$163,000,-000; fortifications, \$11,500,000; agriculture, I1,642,000; District of Columbia, \$11,500,000; diplomatic and consular, \$4,000,000; naval, \$122,662,000; Indian, \$9,000,000; urgent deficiency, \$17,000,-000; military academy, new immigration station at Philadelphia; relief of cyclone sufferers in the South, etc., \$1,-500,000; permanent annual appropriations, \$154,000,000.

These appropriations are for use in the fiscal year beginning July 1 next, and they were made in the teeth of a deficit that will certainly be \$125,000 .-000, and that may go to \$175,000,000. This would exhaust the surplus in the treasury and the first billion-dollar session would have as its new accomplisement a bond issue before July,

PROSPECTS CHEERING.

The government places the area of winter wheat standing on May 1 at 29,-751,000 acres. This acreage is very large and if it holds good until harvest time, it will prove the largest, except those of 1903 and 1906.

The condition of the crop is put by the department of agriculture at 89 per cent. as against 82.9 per cent. one year ago and a 10-year average of 85.5 per cent. The record crop of winter wheat was grown in 1906, when 493,000,000 bushels were harvested from 29,600,000 acres. The present crop may not equal that of 1906, but experts do not hesitate to predict a crop of 450,000,000 bushels.

The government will make no report on spring wheat or oats or corn until June, but all of these crops are said to be coming on handsomely. The prevailing coolness of the weather does not promote the growth of either corn or cotton in this section, but neither is taking great barm, and both are in a position to be benefited by the first spell of sunshine and seasonable

Business men are keenly watching the crop prospects, for nothing will set the railroad wheels a turning like big crops. Nothing means so sharp s boost all along the line. Once let it be established that the country is to have big crops of cotton, corn, wheat and oats, and a powerful trend upward will at once be felt.
