Newspaper Laws.

Postmaster is required to give notice

(returning a paper does not an-

tend) when a subscriber does not

receive his paper out of the office, state the rea-

son for its not being taken; and a neglect

to make the Postmaster responsible to

himself for the paper.

Any person who takes his paper

from the Postoffice, whether directed to

one or another, or whether he has

paid or not, is responsible for the

same.

If the subscriber orders his paper

discontinued, he must pay all arrearages,

or the paper may continue to send, the subscriber

must pay for it if he takes it out of

the Postoffice. The law proceeds on the

principle that a man must pay for what he

has received.

The Courts have decided that refusing

to receive newspapers and periodicals from the

Postoffice, or removing and leaving them un-

paid for is prima facie evidence of intent-

and malice.
