A BURNING MOUNTAIN. Subterranean Conflagration in the far Northwest. OTTAWA, June 29.—A most startling story comes to light here. A party of five young gentlemen from the maritime provinces, under the guidance of an Indian guide, left here two weeks ago to hunt in the Manitow river district, in the northwest territory.

The district in which they went hunting lies about fifty miles to the south of the Canadian Pacific railway track from Brule, on the high lands near the Manitow river. This locality is just north of the United States boundary line from Black Duck lake in Minnesota. They report having left Brule in company with their guide, journeying southward. After traversing some distance they met a mountaineer's family on the way into the town with all their goods and chattels packed on two lean looking horses.

The earth was dry and cracked with the subterranean heat. Dead snakes without number were discovered by the hunters. The heat, instead of diminishing, was found to increase the higher they went up the mountain side, the cracks in the earth widened and new ones appeared, and the locality became uninhabitable.
