## United States Supreme Court Overworked.

Richmond Times-Dispatch. When the United States Supreme Court began its session last fall its docket contained about 1,200 cases. Now it has finished its deliberations for the year, and but 350 cases have been disposed of, although the judges were unusually diligent. The court is two years behind its docket. There is no relief for this condition in sight, and the situation is gradually becoming aggravated.

In 1789 at the organization of the court, it had but six members. Now, after the passing of a century and a quarter, it is larger by only a half, although the nation has developed tremendously, and we have become a litigious people. Since 1898 the court has heard appeal cases from the Philippines and Porto Rico as an additional burden on the docket. "The chief cause of the accumulation is the American trait which impels a litigant to fight to the last ditch," says the Boston Globe.

In 1891 the Circuit Court of Appeals was created for the purpose of relieving the congestion, but the relief was only temporary. It is manifest that the Supreme Court ought to be more prompt in handing down its decisions, but it is a physical impossibility to move much faster than 350 cases the year. This gives each justice about 40 cases, each involving complex and hard propositions of law. The justice must not only sift the facts and apply the law, but must also sit in consultation with his associates in the other cases, some of which are of supreme importance. He must be an unremitting student—in fact, there is little time in the year that he may call his own.

There seems to be but one remedy; to enlarge the court to fifteen or more members. This is objectionable because it is repugnant to judicial ideas to have a large consulting court. It may have to be done, however, if the present agitation against the law's delay continue.

## North Carolina News.

Lillie Brisson a 9-year-old boy—was killed by a train at Lumberton Monday of last week. Caught while crossing the track.

Senator Robert M. LaFollette, of Wisconsin, a leader of the Progressive Republicans, will contest with President Taft for the Republican presidential nomination.

Col. W. J. Bryan, who has been lecturing in South Carolina the last week or so, was invited to address the Press Association at Lenoir this week but declined on account of engagements.

The two-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. John L. Wilkinson, of Charlotte, fell into a tub of boiling water four weeks ago and died Wednesday of last week as a result of the injuries received.

A corps of engineers began work at Salisbury Tuesday a week surveying the proposed railroad line from Salisbury to Monroe. Bonds have been voted by townships in Rowan and Union for the construction of the road.

Two aviators were killed and one injured at Vincennes, France, Sunday. They were part of a company of fifty aviators that had started on a long distance flight and the fatal accident occurred soon after the start was made.

J. H. Eason has instituted suit in Wake county Superior Court against J. C. Jeffreys, for \$10,000 damages. Eason complains that Jeffreys had him arrested on account of a board bill and the suit is for false arrest.

The weather report says that heavy rains which swept the South Atlantic States Sunday and Sunday night effectually ended a drought which has extended from 17 days to more than a month in various sections. Crops generally have been benefited.

Despondency caused by the death Sunday morning of his fiancée, after a very short illness from appendicitis, drove Charles Ricks, the eldest son of Sheriff George E. Ricks, of Washington, (N. C.), to attempt suicide Sunday afternoon by cutting his throat. He is expected to recover.

At a negro festival in Robeson county, Saturday night a week, a combination of whiskey, woman and talk about a baseball game brought on a row which resulted in the death of "Bunk" McRae. There were a half dozen participants in the fight and one is in jail.

In Federal Court at Greensboro last week Sid Allen, a citizen of some prominence in Carroll county, Va., was convicted of perjury and sentenced to two and a half years in the Federal prison in Atlanta. In addition he must pay a fine of \$500. The case was appealed and Allen was released on bond.

Burrill Casey and his wife were arrested at New Bern last week on a bench warrant, to answer the charge of poisoning Joseph Whitty, of Craven county, who died May 19. Mrs. Casey was the wife of Whitty and married Casey three weeks after Whitty's death.

The accident in the mountains of Haywood county Sunday a week, which resulted in the death of four State convicts employed in railroad work and in the injury of others, was due, it is said, to a heavy rainfall, which caused the supports of the building in which the convicts were housed to give way. The convicts were not wearing a hall and chain but were loose in the building. Balls and chains are not used on State convicts. One injured convict has since died, making five fatalities.

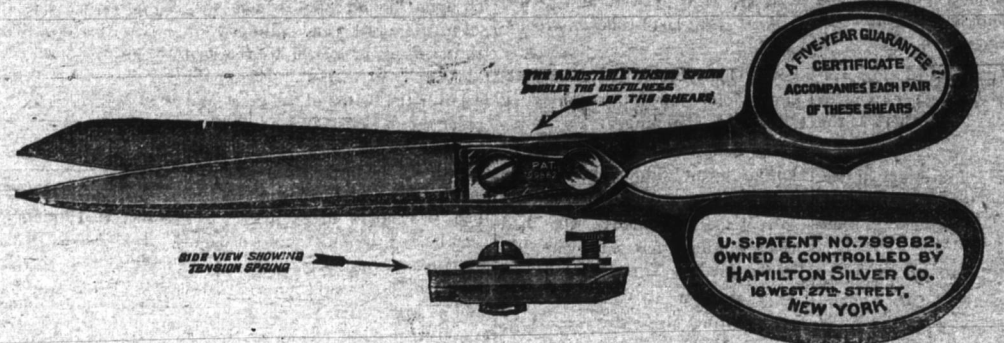

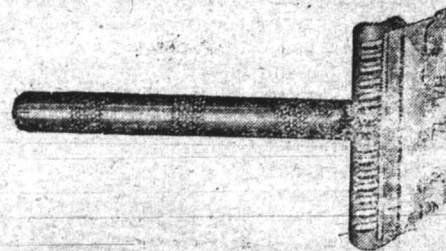
