WRITER TAKES PART IN FIERCE BATTLE.

Tells About it and Part He Took. The following is an extract from a letter of June 10th, written to Statesville by a young officer with the Scotch highlanders in France:

"You will be pleased to note our brilliant success. I will try to make the impression of one who took a lumbago in the leg before everything complete a bit before the battle opened and were standing by it. It was quite a romantic setting, but some little thing before the attack had become quiet, only an occasional shot being fired. The air was very still and a change was due to take place the quiet was very noticeable. The day was just breaking, we could see the outlines of the ridge in front, a lark had just risen about 100 yards in front and was singing. A more peaceful summer morning you could not imagine. Suddenly a dull column of smoke and flame leaped up in the air on our left front, followed by several more along the line. It was a sight never to be forgotten. The earth heaved and swayed in a most alarming manner. Our guns opened up, everything in view was blotted out. We couldn't see 20 yards in front.

"We got our machine guns going, and for the next hour our attention was taken up with our work. They say the bombardment was terrific, can't prove it. The rattle of the gun which I operated so quickly deafened me I couldn't tell much about the artillery fire which was well on the afternoon before I recovered my hearing. By 5 a. m. we could tell the attack had been a great success. We could see our men moving freely on the ridge in front—the ridge which had overlooked our position for two years and which had been the scene of our bloodiest battles. They were terribly shaken up, blanching faces, and some were reeling like drunken men; and some through perspiring faces of their guards. We have since learned that our M. G. barrage was very effective and much appreciated by the infantry. Now you see how little one sees of a modern battle. We thought we might see the advance, but saw nothing. "I have had some thrilling times since and also before the attack, so I am all for the quiet life."

American Troops At Home in France.

LOOKS AMERICAN-LIKE WHERE THEY ARE LOCATED.

Drink More Water Than French—Bathe Often—Have Lively American Music—Camp Has Air of Orderliness.

American Training Camp in France, July 17.—The American troops have been here for less than a week—they are not here by any means—and they have already made themselves thoroughly at home, so much so that this section of France looks like a little bit of America.

The correspondent made an extended visit to the encampments this morning and found the men fit and in good spirits, and full of praise for the friendly co-operation of the French people, who have willingly and gladly given up many of their own comforts to accommodate all the Americans who have arrived and so the country-side is dotted with newly erected barracks that have sprung up over night and make even more picturesque this beautiful neighborhood.

Water is abundant here, but uncertain as to purity, so the troops are adopting filtering methods by means of bags suspended from tri-ropes, which ascertain the local inhabitants almost as much as the American's inexhaustible thirst for water, which is known to wine drinkers, many of whom seldom touch water.

It is a task which the army had taken upon itself in the clearing up of the entire countryside and at the present pace the whole district will soon look like a well-ordered garden. Such prisoners as are under arrest for minor infractions of the regulations are employed each morning in making headquarters spotless and are bringing such a degree of orderliness into the place that the original residents are amazed. Likewise they find it difficult to understand why the soldiers take so many baths, for the men make for the nearest stream and dive in as soon as they are at liberty.

The presence of the soldiers here has naturally introduced many novelties, but probably none is more welcome than the daily evening concert, which attracts people from far around, people chiefly who have never heard lively American music and who have been without music since the outbreak of the war.

An attractive feature of the camp is a lion cub, which occupies a corner in the camp of a certain regiment. The cub was presented as a mascot by American residents in Paris. He was young and playful and harmless a short time ago, but is growing astonishingly and is a veritable terror to the townspeople and now a source of doubtful amusement to the soldiers, many of whom bear scratches to testify to the nature of his playfulness.

An even more strenuous course of training is in force here than at the original camp near the landing point of the troops. The men work a minimum of eight hours a day; the officers from 12 to 16. In addition, they take tremendous hikes to get into condition. Here and there one falls by the wayside by the exertion, but the majority are standing the gaff in a way that speaks volumes for the efficiency of the system.
