J. Archie Long, cashier of the Bank of Haw River, accompanied by Mrs. Long, was held up at 12:30 last Friday near J. F. Parks filling station on highway between Burlington and Haw River and robbed of a thousand dollars, which Mr. Long had secured from a Burlington bank.
