

STATE FINANCES.

The biennial report of State Treasurer Bain, the News-Courier says, shows that the balance on hand November 30th, 1884, was \$947,068.56, and November 30, 1885, was \$682,521.82. The ordinary revenues during 1885 were \$299,017.02; during 1886, \$650,601.03, the large increase of revenues the latter year being due to the success of the State lottery.

The treasurer reports the investment in four per cent State bonds, and the compromise annuities and settlement of the State debt required by law, and gives the total recognized debt of the State as \$12,027,045.

The report also addresses the question of the State debt, and recommends that the act of March 4th, 1870, be extended to January 1st, 1880.
