

Care of Harness.

Courier Journal. Much money is wasted annually for want of care of harness. It is as easy to hang them up in the stable, where the fumes of ammonia and dust from the horses readily reach them, than to carry them to a separate and clean room. Oiling should be done about twice each year. Take apart, scrub well in warm water, scrape brush, and leave until dry on the outside, but yet soft and pliable. Rub in thoroughly a good quality of harness oil, with a little beeswax and glycerine melted in it, and enough lampblack to color it. Let it dry in a cool, shady place until the oil is all soaked in. Three days are better than one. Then rub off with a rag or sponge dampened with thick castile soap. Never oil without having the harness damp, and always in the sun or by the stove to dry the oil in.
