MORE TOWNS MAKE IMPROVE-

Health Is Not Estimated in Dollars and Cents.

Old Fort and Hertford are the next North Carolina towns° to make notable municipal improvements. Old Fort the main gateway to the mountains proper, with a population of not over 1000, has contracted for a sanitary sewer system to cost around \$10,000. Hertford, the quaint old town on the Perquimans, has gone two farther. She has contracted for waterworks, electric lighting and a sanitary sewer system, together with street improvements on specified streets. Hertford is a town of about 2,000 people, some 60 percent of which are negroes. The

lowest figures for Hertford's improvements, not to include street improvement, will be about \$55,000. The small town of 1,000 or more nhabitants are today making the municipal improvements that towns of 15,000 or 20,000 inhabitants made just few years ago. Regardless of war imes these towns feel that they cantot afford to make these principal safeguards in defense of health and

afety. It is an encouraging sign when small towns realize that they must provide "safety first" for their people, regardless of the money cost.

A TIME SAVER.

How Anti-Typhoid Vaccine Saves Time From Sick Leave in the Army. Typhoid fever used to be a time killer. Now the efficiency experts have knocked it clean out of the box. In the army, navy and elsewhere, where men are off duty or laid in a hospit al at the employers' expense, care ful records of the loss of time on ac count of various causes were kept. For six years prior to the introduction of anti-typhoid vaccine- in the army in 1910, our soldiers lost time on account of sickness from typhoid at the rate of over 71 days every year for an army of 100,000. In 1910, when anti-typhoid vaccination was offered the soldiers if they cared to take it,

enough of them took it to reduce this daily loss of time leave in the army from 71 to 49. In March, 1911, antityphoid vaccination became compulsory and for that year the rate was still further reduced from 49 to 20. In
