

crime not to be able to enjoy it. Cheese and Pea Salad.—Take a quarter of a pound of cream cheese, can of peas, two small onions, three sweet pickles, three sour pickles, some crisp lettuce, half a cupful of chopped and all mixed together with a good salad dressing.

Pineapple, Cheese and Nut Salad .-Take slices of pineapple from the can, fill the centers with grated cheese, cover with French dressing, and sprinkle with chapped auts and paraley. To make French dressing, the amount of vinegar or lemon juice is varied to suit the character of the salad. A salad which is acid will need but little added to the oil. One tablespoonful of lemon juice to three of olive oil, salt and paprika or red pepper to taste, with occasional use onton futee, a pinch of mustard or white pepper, Salmon Salad Take one can of sal-

mon, four cold boiled potatoes, three sweet pickles, two cunfuls of cabbage finely chopped and any desired dressing. Cut the potatoes and pickles into mall pieces and mix with the salmon which has been finked and the bones removed; mix with a good boiled

Dainty Chicken Salad.—To one cup-ful of cold cooked chicken cut in small pieces, add one cupful of walnut meats, one cupful of peas and a cupful of mayonnaise dressing and a few chopped olives. Mix and arrange on crisp lettuce leaves. Garnish with
