BRITISH SORE OVER
HOSPITAL SHIP LOSS

WHEAT GROWERS IN FAVORED POSITION

Will be Allowed to Grind Entire Season's Supply of Flour From Home Grown Wheat—Food Administrator Page Announces New Program.

With the coming in of the new wheat crop, North Carolina farmers who were patriotic and wise enough to raise their own wheat will be al-lowed to have an entire senson's sup-ply of flour ground. The only condition to time privilege, according to State Food Administrator Henry A. Page, is that while wheat is still in poor milling condition, a supply sufficient to last until October 1 shall be ground.
