LABOR'S PROPOSAL TO PEACE

Submitted By U. S. Delegates on Com-mission of Labor Legislation. Paris, Feb. 8.—The American dele-gates on the commission of interna-tional labor legislation of the peace conference, has submitted the follow

ing proposals to the commission:
"We declare that the following fundamental principles should underlies and be incorporated in the peace

LEAGUE OF FREE PEOPLES. "A league of the tree peoples of the world in a common covenant for genuine and practical co-operation to se-cure justice and, therefore, peace in the relations between nations;

"The entrance of any free nation into the league of free peoples of the world shall be inherent;
"No reprisals based upon purely vindictive purposes, or deliberate desire to injure, but to right manifest wrong;
"Recognition of the rights of nations and of the rights of nations and of the principle no people must be forced under a sovereignty un-der which it does not wish to live;

der which it does not wish to live;
"No territorial changes or adjustments of power except in the furtherance of the welfare of the peoples affected and in the furtherance of world

HUMAN LABOR NOT A COMMODITY "That in law and in practice the principle shall be recognized that the labor of a human being is not a commodity or an article of commerce;
"Involuntary servitude shall not exist except in a punishment for crime of which the party abell where

"Trials by jury should be establish-NO ABRIDGEMENT OF FREEDOM.

"The right of free association, free assemblage, free speech and the press shall not be denied or abridged; "That the seamen of the merchant marine shall be guaranteed the right or reaving their vessels when the same

ped or delivered in international merce in the production of which children under the age of sixteen years have been employed or parmitted to

"It shall be declared that the work day in industry and commerce shall not exceed eight hours per day except in case of extraordinary emergency,

"The sale or use for commercial purposes of articles made or manufactur-ed in private homes shall be prohibi-

"It shall be declared that an ade-quate wage shall be paid for labor per-formed—a wage based upon and com-mensurate with the standards of pay conforming to the civilization of the

"That equal wages shall be paid .to romen as is paid to men for equal work performed: "The incorporation of the points laid down by President Wilson."
