ACCIDENT CAUSED ZR-2 WRECK IS VERDICT

Hull, Oct. 4.—The catastrophe to the giant airship ZR-2, over the Humber river on August 24, in which more than forty persons, including sixteen Americans, lost their lives, was due to accident, according to the verdict reached by the coroner's jury at the resumed inquest here today. There is no evidence as to the actual cause of the disaster, the verdict says. This verdict was rendered in the case of Lieutenant Commander Charles G. Little of the American navy, which was the first to be considered by the coroner's jury. A similar verdict was rendered in
