Hull, Oct. 4.—The catastrophe to the giant airship ZR-2, over the Humber river on August 24, in which more than forly persons, including sixteen Americans, lost their lives, was due to accident, according to the verdict reached by the reached by the coroner's jury at the resumed inquest here today.
