IT PAYS TO USE GOOD COTTON SEED

Raleigh, Jan. 8.—Many cotton growers think because of the boll weevil it will pay to plant varieties of cotton like King because this variety matures early. Tests made by agronomy workers of the State College and Department of Agriculture, show, however, that those varieties which continue to set fruit during the entire season are more profitable because the weevil attacks the squares and thus leaves the bolls to harden into maturity without damage. Such varieties as Mexican Big Boll, Cleveland Big Boll and some other improved varieties have been recommended by Dr. R. Y. Winters and his co-workers because years of investigation have shown that these varieties do best under North Carolina conditions. Dr. Winters has available a list of North Carolina breeders who have improved their seed and are continuing to make them better each year. These names will be furnished to any farmer who will take the trouble to write Dr. Winters at the State College. He finds that it pays to stick to our own standard bred seeds despite the somewhat earnest effort now being made by growers from other sections to get some of the seed business of this

State.

As an example of how good seed will improve yields, a farmer in Mecklenburg County crop planted part of his cotton to the King variety and the remainder to Cook's Improved. When he was ready to gin, he loaded one wagon with 1250 pounds of King seed cotton and another with 1250 pounds of Cook's. His bale of Cook cotton weighed 495 pounds and his bale of King weighed 450 pounds. This is a difference of 45 pounds of lint with cotton selling above 30 cents. This man reported to County Agent Kope Elias that he had been taught a lesson that he would not soon forget.
