

Milkers Take Notice!



"The milkers should be on good terms with the cow. If milkers scold and kick, the cow will, most likely, return the latter; and moreover, she cannot kick to advantage when her leg is in close conjunction with the milker. The best milkers are the quickest; for there will be a flow in less than a minute from the commencement of the process. Take advantage of this, and prevent its return. Milk dry; for the striplings are worth four times as much for butter as the milk that is first drawn. This is good advice. A lazy, scolding milker will soon spoil a good cow."
