RMY FLIERS PREPARE FOR LONGEST FLIGHT; NO TRACE OF MARTIN

Bremerton, Washington, May 10.— (By the Associated Press.)—On Attu Island, fartherest west bit of land be-longing to North America, three pilots and three machines of the States Army Air Service rested tonight awaiting the moment when they can take the longest jump of a flight around the world in which they have been engaged since March 17.

In the meanwhile on the Alask peninseula and in the waters of the Pacific ocean Southward and the ice of the Bering Sea, northward, 1,300 miles eastward from the pausing of adventures, a plodding search contin ued for their comrade, Major Fredrick L. Martin, missing since he took the air 10 days ago with his mechanic Staff Sergeant Alva L. Hravey, at Chignik, Alaska.

It was believed here that the fliers on Attu, commanded now by Lieuten ant Lowell H. Smith, would several days preparing for their flight of 878 miles to the Kurile Islands of Japan. Well rested by hunting, fishing, hiking and sailing on Atka Island, they yes-terday did the 530 miles to Attu in 10

AGAINST LAW FIXING PRICES

Raleigh, May 12.—The board of di-ectors of the North Carolina Cotton Growers Cooperative Association have laced themselves on record as being positively opposed to the passage of any law of the United States fixing the price of farm commodities. In a resolution adopted by the board of irectors and sent by their instructions to the members of the House of Re-precentatives and the Searcters of North Carolina the board says, "The board of directors of the North Carolina Cotton Growers Association after con-sidering the matter of legislative fixing of prices on farm commodities is convinced that such action would be economically unsound, that it would not give the desired relief, that it would encourage the dumping of farm pro-duct on the market within a short period immediately following harvest and would, therefore, result in the violation of the principles and pur-poses of cooperative marketing. Now therefore, be it resolved that this board looks with disf. for on any effort on the part of the Government to determine prices on farm commo-
