SHARP GAINS IN PRICE OF WHEAT

Official Confirmation of Huge Crop Losses in Argentina Responsible

Chicago, Dec. 15.—(AP).—Wheat prices whirled upward 5 1-4 cents a bushel today, chiefly as a result of huge crop losses in Argentina officially confirmed by the Argentine government.
