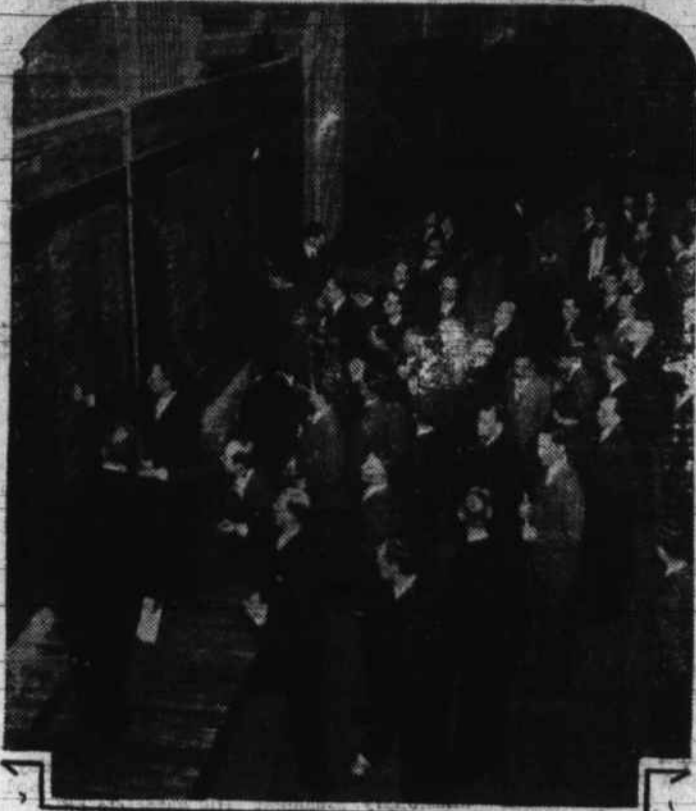


They're Real Butter and Egg Men

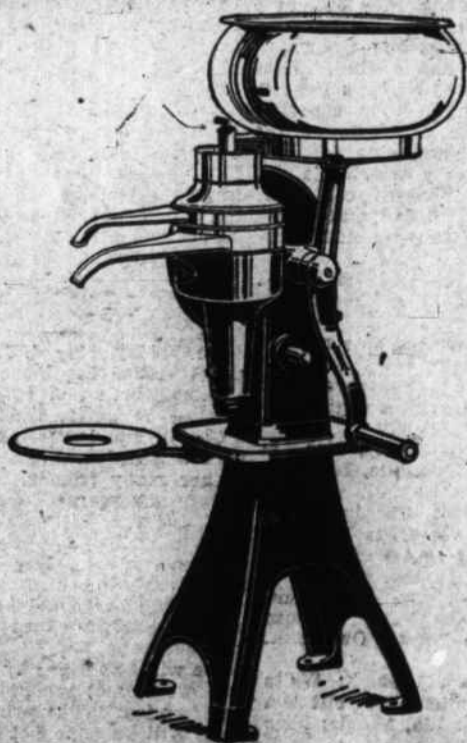
