SELECT BEST BIRDS
IN MATING POULTRY FIRST in Insurance in Force.

Correct mating of poultry for greatest profits during the coming year is a difficult problem and one

N. W. Williams, practical poultry-man in charge of the State College

flocks, says mating poultry is a hard job for the experienced poultryman and that the inexperienced man genand that the independent man gen-erally gives it no consideration at all. However, it is one of the most important jobs to be undertaken at the beginning of the new poultry

. First the grower must know what he wants. If he wants egg produc-tion, he must mate birds that have en producing eggs. If he wants ow birds, he must use those that have the standard conformations. To mate birds for egg productio

the poultrymen ought to understand what hody factors indicate high egg production, says Williams. Select those of standard weight that are vigorous, broad, deep and with large body capacity. Such birds will lay more eggs and the chicks will be stronger than those from birds which do not have such desirable charact-eristics. If the hens lack some of these good qualities but are good layers, use a male bird which will correct the deficiency in the chicks. No bird should be used in the breeding pens which has a tendency to be

In mating for show purposes, careful breeding must be done through several generations. Birds with any disqualifications such as split wings, wry tail, side sprigs and foreign color in the feathers should never be used as breeders because the unde sirable features have a tendency to croop out in the resulting chicks, says Williams. He urges that much attention be given to selecting the male bird both when breeding for eggs or for show purposes.
