Who may apply for Tenant Purchase Loans?-United States citizens who are farm tenants (not owners), share-croppers, farm laborers, or others who obtain or recently have obtained most of their income from farm-

Must I have a farm selected before I apply?-No. It is usually advisable to talk with the County Supervisor and the County Committee before choosing a farm.

What are the terms of the loans?-Loans are made for a 40-year period at 3 per cent in-

terest. How large will the annual payments be?—Annual payments of 4.3 per cent of the sum borrowed will cover both interest and prin-

May I pay off the entire loan in less than 40 years?—Yes. The Act provides that after five years payment in full may be made at any time.

How will the loans be secured? -By a first mortgage or deed of trust on the farm purchased. The borrower must agree to pay taxes and insurance on the farm buildings, to keep the farm in repair, and prevent waste and exhaustion of the land.


