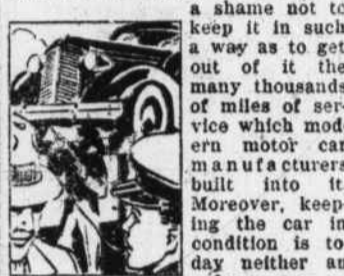
Halifax Succeeds Eden

Mileage Hints

One sound reason for taking good care of the modern automobile is that it is so very useful. There are many places one can go these days with an automobile that it is a shame not to keep it in such a way as to get out of it the many thousands of miles of service which modern motor car manufacturers built into it. Moreover, keeping the car in condition is today neither an arduous nor an expensive matter. It is something which can be done by any motorist once he makes up his mind to do it. It is really surprising that more persons do not take good care of their cars and keep them in such condition that they will run efficiently and economically for many years.



When one considers that the United States has 3,065,000 miles of highway of which 533,144 miles are public roads and streets under state control one has a better idea of the usefulness of the motor car. Today we have upwards of 340,000 miles of primary state roads and a network of close to 400,000 miles of surfaced highways. Of this surfaced mileage 130,000 miles are classed as high-type surfacing. From 1922 to 1935 alone the mileage of cement concrete highways rose from 73,984 miles to 89,300 miles.

It is really surprising that more persons do not take good care of their cars and keep them in such condition that they will run efficiently and economically for many years. It takes more courage to decide to do a thing than it does to do it.
