It is specified that the condition stipulated in subparagraph one above may be waived in instances in which the female applicant is pregnant and it is necessary to protect the le gitimacy of the offspring. In such a case certificate may be granted and license issued provided the applicant with syphilis signs an agreement to take adequate, approved treatment until cured or probated. (2).
