Twenty two farmers attended the meeting and visited with me farms where square counts were made for purpose of determining percentage of squares punctured. On two fields observed. 50% infestation was found on one and 90% on the other. Several mature boll weevils were located. Farmers indicated the desire to dust to control damage expected from weavils.
