No child with physical defects can do himself, his parents or teachers justice and frequently will be a repeater. This becomes an added expense to his school and the State.

Last year the Health Department made a physical survey of the school children of Franklin County. Six thousand one hundred and fifteen children were examined, white 3,780, colored 2,335; with one or more defects 4.809

1,833 colored or 78.5 per cent.
The defects were as follows:

A highly respectable mid-western family, the father was a bishop of the United Brethren church and later publisher of a religious newspaper; but the family never had a lot of money. Orville Wright started to make money early in life, going about the neigh-borhood and collecting old bones to sell to a fertilizing plant.
