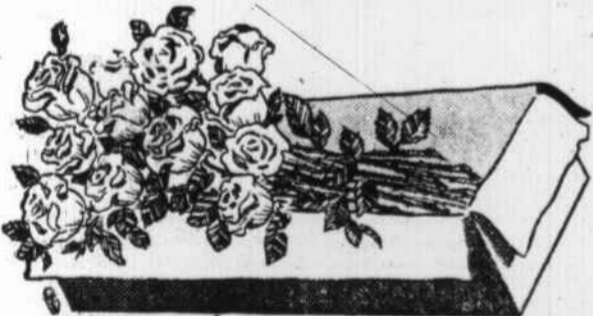

VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL AT LOUISBURG BAPTIST CHURCH

The vacation season here and the date is set for Vacation Bible School in the Baptist Church. Beginning on Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock Preparation Day will be observed. The boys and girls are asked to come to the church, enroll, get instructions about the school and take part in the parade.

The Vacation School session will have its first regular program on Tuesday morning, May 21, beginning at 8:30 A. M. and running until 11:00 A. M.

The boys and girls will get three hours of definite Bible study, church music, character stories, missionary study, notebook work, memory scripture drill, handwork and recreation. This year the theme of the school is based on "Peace Education of Young People."

ONE LOUISBURG NEGRO WOUNDED CRITICALLY, ANOTHER IS SHOT BY MISTAKE

Two Negroes were wounded, one critically, in a early morning shooting here Sunday at the home of Ed Webb in the Negro section. Police Chief C. E. Pace investigated and is holding Jessie Boone, Negro, pending outcome of wounds suffered by Arthur Mitchell and Sid Williams.

Mitchell was critically hurt, being shot through the jaw, chest and left lung, right thigh. However, Dr. Herbert Perry said the Negro had a fair chance to recover. When Boone allegedly opened fire on Mitchell, he attempted to shield himself behind Sid Williams, and Williams was caught in the cross-fire, being wounded in one leg. He was not injured seriously. Chief Pace said an argument over a woman led to the shooting.

LAST CALL

MOLASSES and CALCIUM ARSENATE

The second and possibly last car of Molasses will arrive in Louisburg around the 20th of May. Be sure of getting your materials by placing your order NOW.

HOW TO PREPARE AND USE THE MOLASSES, CALCIUM ARSENATE POISON (1-1-1 Mixture)

1. Buy your poison materials early so they will be on hand when needed.

2. The materials needed are 3 pounds of calcium arsenate and 3 gallons of thick black-strap molasses for each acre of cotton. These materials will usually be enough to make 3 applications per acre.

3. Make a mop from an old sack or similar material by folding a piece of the sack and tacking it to a stick or slat. The mop should be about 3 inches wide and should extend about 3 to 6 inches beyond the end of the stick. Cut the end of the mop into strips about 1 inch wide.

4. In preparing the sweetened poison, first mix 1 pound of calcium arsenate and 1 gallon of water and stir thoroughly. Continue stirring and slowly add 1 gallon of molasses. Keep well stirred and apply the poison the same day it is mixed.
