be planted in October, at least. Prepare the soil well before planting any bulbs. The soil should be pulverized and worked to a depth of at least 10 inches. Commercial fertilizer at a rate of three pounds per 100 square feet may be used if mixed well with the soil. A complete fertilizer high in potash is recommended. A two-inch layer of well-rotted manure may be used if it is worked thoroughly into the soil. Cover each bulb with twice its own depth of soil.
