**MEETING OF BOARD OF EQUALIZATION AND REVIEW FOR 1942**

Under and by virtue of the authority contained in Chapter 310 of the Public Laws of 1939, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Franklin will convene as a Board of Equalization and Review, for the purpose of equalizing the valuation of all property in the County, to the end that such property shall be listed on the tax records at the valuation required by law; and the said Board will correct the tax records for each township so that they will conform to the provisions of law; the Board will, on request, hear tax payers and examine and review the tax lists of each township for the current year; and will of its own motion or on sufficient cause shown by any person list and assess any real or personal property or polls, subject to taxation in the County, omitted from said lists; and will correct all errors in the names of persons, in the description of property, and in the assessment

and valuation of any taxable property appearing on said lists; and will otherwise comply with the provisions of said Chapter 310 of the Public Laws of 1939.

The first meeting of said Board of Equalization and Review will convene in the Commissioners' room in the courthouse of said County of Franklin, at ten o'clock, A. M., on Monday, the 23rd day of March, 1942, and will adjourn from day to day until the work of the said Board shall be completed, but said Board shall not meet later than 13 April 1942.
