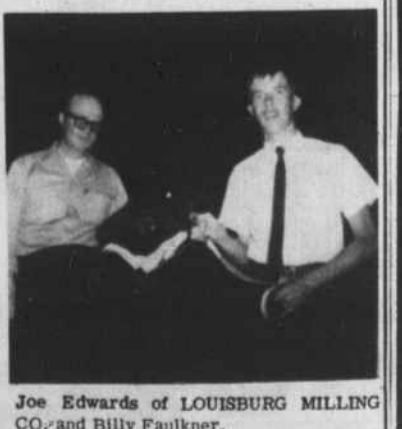

"The Man In The Middle"

Taking place in India during World War II, "Man In The Middle" marks the vivid difference in the pace of life of the native of India and the American and English troops stationed near New Delhi. Tense and war, loneliness of location bear heavily on an American Lieutenant (Keenan Wynn) and for no apparent reason he murders a British staff sergeant.

The American general (Barry Sullivan) is anxious for a quick trial and execution. But, the American Army attorney (Robert Mitchum) is holding out for an examination by a psychiatrist--for he is certain the Lieutenant was insane and incapable of facing trial.

Thus, Mitchum (well capable of the part) is actually the "man in the middle."

Much of the action takes place in the court room. Actors seem authentic in their parts and an interesting film results. France Nuyen is the only girl in the story and her part was that of a nurse--created solely to that end.
