

Louisburg, Franklinton Meet For County Football Honors

The Louisburg Bulldogs, still looking their first win, travel to Franklinton for a Homecoming clash with the Rams, who are 1-2 for the season, Friday night.

The contest, which always draws large crowds, will see a much improved Franklinton squad and a Louisburg eleven plagued with injuries. Both teams lost heartbreakers last week. Louisburg fell to Norlina with a little more than a minute to go in the game, 7-6 and the Rams bowed to Wakelton by the exact same margin.

Franklinton holds an opening game win against Spring Hope, a team that beat Louisburg the following week, 6-0. The Rams subsequently lost to Oxford Orphanage and Louisburg fell to Warrenton.

Franklinton has a new coach, although not new to the team. Hiram J. Guedalia, long-time head basketball and assistant football coach took over the

reigns of the football program this year. He is assisted by two former college football players, Bill James of N. C. State University and Charlie Blackwelder of East Carolina University.

Louisburg is coached by Ivey Bolton, now in his third year at the helm and a new assistant coach, Tommy Twitty of Warrenton. Twitty will be head basketball coach. In the nine year, ten-game

rivalry, Louisburg has dominated with nine wins and only one loss. Franklinton won in 1964, 6-0. In 1958, Franklinton's first year of football, the teams met twice. Louisburg, starting its football pro-

gram in 1957, won both games. Last year, the Bulldogs won by a score of 25-6.

Game time is 8 P.M. on the Franklinton Athletic Field and no one is predicting the outcome.

Legion To Study Baseball Project

The American Legion Post here will study the possibility of forming an American Legion baseball program for the area, according to Post Commander George Champion, Jr.

Louisburg College Athletic Director and baseball coach, Russell Frazier, will address the Post in a meeting here Friday night. Frazier is expected to explain to the Legionaires the procedures for setting up the baseball program.

Legion ball consists of 10th, 11th and 12th grade students and team members can be chosen from 3700 such students in the area. This number

indicates that should a program be set up here, some players might come from any any place in the county and some, perhaps, from outside the county.

Any local team would probably be a part of the league with Raleigh and other larger cities in the area.

A great deal of interest has been expressed in the county for a strong baseball program.

Champion said his organization would study the possibility after hearing Frazier. The American Legion sponsors such programs throughout the country.

1. What driver holds the record for number of wins at the NASCAR super-Speedways 1959-1967?
2. Many race fans connect Jole Chitwood solely with auto thrill shows, but he raced seven times in the Indy 500. Can you name his best finishes?
