"Major Pergerson's detailed study of the required aviation command and control structure, and his briefings on the subject of major commanders, initiated actions to provide effective and efficient control of the still expanding aviation forces in the combat zone."

His wife, Jane, lives at 506 Jamestown Ave., Fayetteville, N.C. The major graduated in 1954 from North Carolina State University, Raleigh, N.C. He received his commission through the Reserve Officers' Training Corps program at the university.

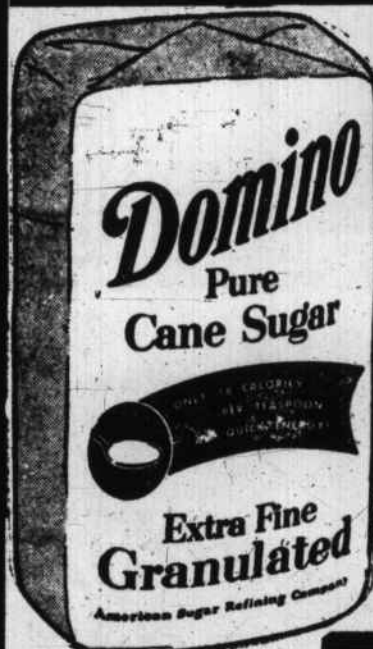
