The months of January and Fegruary, and sometimes March, are the worst to endure for worshippers of the sun and those who detest cold weather. In the United States many head southward, especially to southern Florida in these months.

One can find warmth deep in Texas or in the far west, in New Mexico, Arizona and California but for swimming the best bet is where Richard Nixon has bought a home-- in southern Florida. Even there cold spells like a freeze which damaged the citrus crop in mid-December can curtail summer-time sports.

New Orleans and the Gulf coast can be nice in mid-winter but can also be miserable The time to begin visiting the Jacksonville, Mobile, New Orleans latitude is early March By that time this area is relatively safe from hard cold and signs of spring are abundant

For the area slightly above this east-west Gulf coastline, such as South Carolina and westward, early April, or very late in March, is the earliest that good weather is assured. For Virginia and westward late April is a safer time for touring.

For Pennsylvania and above one would do well not to expect warm weather before May. Isolating and controlling the rhinoviruses is the major ob-stacle to a cold vaccine. Small in size, about the same dimen-sions as the polio virus, rhinoviruses grow best at 91.4 de-grees. The human body temperature is 98.6. Clear enough, then, why the rhinoviruses have such a happy hunting ground along air-cooled nasal passages.

Some 40 million Americans who become cold victims will visit their doctors this year. Many more will merely talk about them, and pass their colds on to relatives, friends and neighbors. But a goodly number will be getting proven relief from the Novahistine family.
