Transferred To Delaware

James I. Perkerson, husband of the former Jocelyn Martin of Route 2, Zebulon, was transferred from his position of Supervisor of Materials Control at the Volunteer Army Ammunition Plant in Chattanooga, Tennessee to the newly created position of Purchasing Research Analyst in Atlas Chemical Industries' Wilmington, Delaware headquarters on February 1.

Perkerson joined VAAP as a buyer in January, 1966 and was promoted to Purchasing Agent in December of that year. In September, 1968, he was made Supervisor of Materials Control.

Prior to coming to VAAP, he was a buyer with Boeing Company, Huntsville, Alabama. Previously he was sales office manager for a real estate firm in Montgomery, Alabama, and sales representative with Hallmark Cards, also in Montgomery.

While Purchasing Agent at Volunteer, Mr. Perkerson was responsible for efforts resulting in \$4 million savings during fiscal year 1968. He had been previously commended by the plant manager for cost savings of \$23,500.

Born in Columbus, Mississippi, Mr. Perkerson is the son of Mr. and Mrs. E. A. Perkerson of that city. He is a 1952 graduate of Lee High School and earned his degree in business administration from Mississippi College in Clinton, Mississippi in 1956. He also attended Mississippi State University for 18 months and has taken post-graduate work at the University of Alabama. He was in the U. S. Army from 1956 through 1959, spending two years in Europe.

A member of Rivermont Golf and Country Club and the Oakwood Baptist Church, he also belongs to the National Association of Purchasing Management and was chairman of the public relations committee of the Chattanooga chapter of that organization.

Jocelyn and their 15 month old son, William Douglas, will be staying with her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Brodie Martin in Pilot, until their home in Wilmington has been completed. After the first of April, they hope to settle in their new house on Darthmouth Woods Drive.
