Medical Practice Change Outlined By Dr. Parham

Dr. S. Malone Parham, Henderson gynecologist and obstetrician, today announced the exclusion of routine or normal obstetric delivery from his practice, which will now be limited to gynecology and gynecologic (female) surgery and consultant and complicated obstetrics. The deletion does not, of course, exclude the routine private obstetric patients already seen prenatally and scheduled for delivery; however, no new expectant patients will be accepted unless the need for major instrumental delivery or major surgery is anticipated or develops, Dr. Parham said. Consultation and assistance in obstetrics as well as gynecology to all of the other local physicians will continue as before. If local circumstances change in the future so as to make resumption of routine obstetrics feasible, this will be reconsidered, the doctor explained. The Vance county prenatal and postpartum and interval cancer detection clinics have had to be increased because of volume of patients and will continue to be held on Thursday by Dr. Parham at the Vance County Health Center. The clinics are intended for, but not necessarily restricted to, those unable to afford private office care, he said.
