### Garden Time

May is a busy month in the flower, vegetable and fruit gardens. In our neighborhood all plants have been growing real well but will slow down considerably unless we have rain real soon.

Perennial grasses are becoming dormant (turning brown) unless they have been watered.

Dahlias planted the latter part of May seem to perform better than earlier planted

tubers. Be sure to have one good "eye" (growing point) on each tuber.

If you are concerned about ants infesting your peony flowers, don't worry. They are only seeking a sweet substance secreted by the flowers.

The planting of tender vegetables is in order in the lower Piedmont (5-8-69), and in the Coastal Plain. Wait until danger of frost has passed.

ed in the mountains. Set out tomatoes, eggplants, peppers, and sweet potatoes. Sow snapbeans, sweet corn, okra, squash and cucumbers. Cantaloupes and watermelons may also be planted.

Don't expect to have disease and insect-free apples, peaches or bunch grapes unless you protect the plants with suitable sprays to control the many pests attacking them. "All-purpose" pesticides may be purchased to protect your peaches, plums and apples. They should be applied regularly and according to instructions printed on the label.

For bunch grapes, I would spray every two weeks with either Bordeaux mixture and Malathion; or Captain and Malathion. Sevin may be substituted for Malathion in both cases.

Plant such crops as elephant ears, fancy-leaved caladiums, cannas, tuberose, crinums and gladioli. The latter should be planted every two weeks for continuous bloom.

Watch for chlorosis - insufficient green color in leaves resulting in a mottled yellowish appearance. This condition is most likely to appear on the foliage of azaleas, rhododendrons, roses and grasses. Sometimes other plants are also affected.

The trouble is caused by an iron deficiency and may be corrected by spraying or sprinkling the plants with iron chelates. These materials can be purchased from your garden supply store and should be used according to instructions.

If you have much chlorosis, have your soil tested. Soil that is too alkaline (sweet) will tie up the iron and make it unavailable to the plant.
