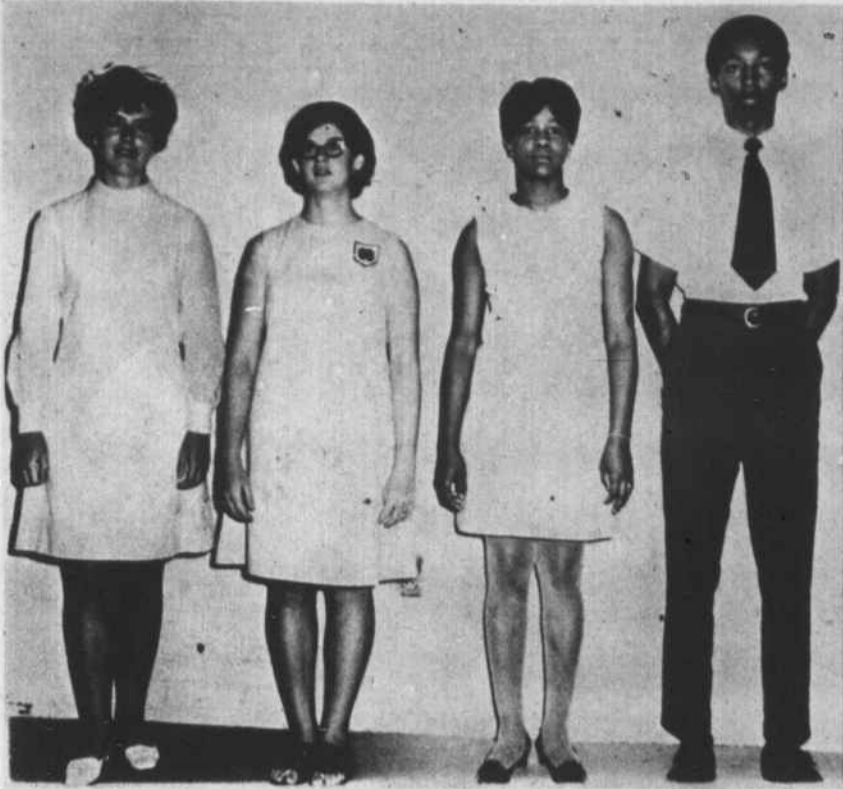


District Winners Announced
