RESOLUTION CALLING SPECIAL ELECTION

WHEREAS, the 1969 Session of the North Carolina General Assembly enacted Chapter 1228 S.L. 1969, amending Article 5 of Chapter 105 of the General Statutes of North Carolina by adding thereto a new division ignated as Division IX, and entitled "Local Option Sales and Use Tax Act"; and WHEREAS, under the

Section 1. That a special election is called and shall be held in Franklin County on Tuesday, November 4, 1969. for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters the question as to whether there shall be levied and collected in Franklin County a one per cent (1%) local sales and use tax.

Section 2. That the Chairman of the Franklin County Board of Elections is directed to give at least 20 days public notice prior to the opening of
