## SHOE ON THE WRONG FOOT.

The way things political and official are conducted in this country is wrong and the people should take it in their hands and make a remedy. A candidate will run all over the county and humbly plead and beg the people for their votes to put him (it) a good comfortable job at their expense and just as soon as he is safely landed, the same people who placed him there must come in "humble petition" if they want him to do his plain duty. We do not mean this is the case always and in individual cases, but it is always so with boards of commissioners, and councils, and men in the higher positions. This is putting the "shoe on the wrong foot." The people are the source of power, they elect men to office by their voluntary votes and as such the men so elevated become, or should become, the servants of the people and instead of being petitioned, should be directed to do what the people want done. We do not in any way wish to cast reflections upon duly elected and legally constituted authority, but it is pitiful when a people are forced to humbly petition the men they have elected to serve them, to do things that are manifestly the plain duty of the officials so elected. The petitioning of a board of commissioners, for instance, to open a road, repair a street, fix a bridge, or a congressman to aid in passing certain laws or to vote against certain legislation is the wrong way to get at it. Write them, talk to them and let them know by concerted action what is desired, but do not call it a "petition" but an order.

## Bomb Explosion in Portugal Kills Five

Oporto, Portugal, March 20.—Five men were killed and nine others wounded by bomb explosions in the suburb of Miragaya last night. Among the dead is a barber named Costa, who was the real leader of the party organized for the defense of the republic. He was engaged with the others in manufacturing bomb, the ultimate use of which is not known.

The roar of the explosion was heard for miles. Four houses were reduced to ruins and the authorities believe that the bodies of other persons are buried beneath the debris. Two arrests have been made.

## Will Dredge the Catawba For Gold.

The company will dredge about five miles of the river bed for the float gold which abounds in the river sands. Messrs. Gault and Gines, of Bridgeport, Conn., have charge of the work.

## COUNTY HOME.

We understand that Haywood county, one of the most progressive counties in Western North Carolina, is just finishing a new modern county home for the indigent of that county. This is a very commendable step and one that should be followed by other counties. We believe that it is much more important to properly house and care for poor and unfortunate of a county than it is to build fine jails and court houses to try and confine the law breakers in. Many of the unfortunate poor never cost the tax-payers of the county a cent in the way of court costs and are only inmates of the county home by force of circumstances over which they had no control and yet they are not as well provided for as the lawbreakers and criminals who must be confined to prevent their depredations upon their neighbors. The plan is not right, provide and properly house the poor unfortunates of the county first and then take care of the county officials at the court house and if anything is left confine the criminals in good jails also, or better still, work them on the roads. In connection with the county home in every county, there should be a model farm, conducted by a practical farmer and made an object lesson for the people of the county. In this way the instruction would practically be self-sustaining and give the poor unfortunates of the home, who are unable to work, some place in which they could pleasantly and profitably spend their last days.

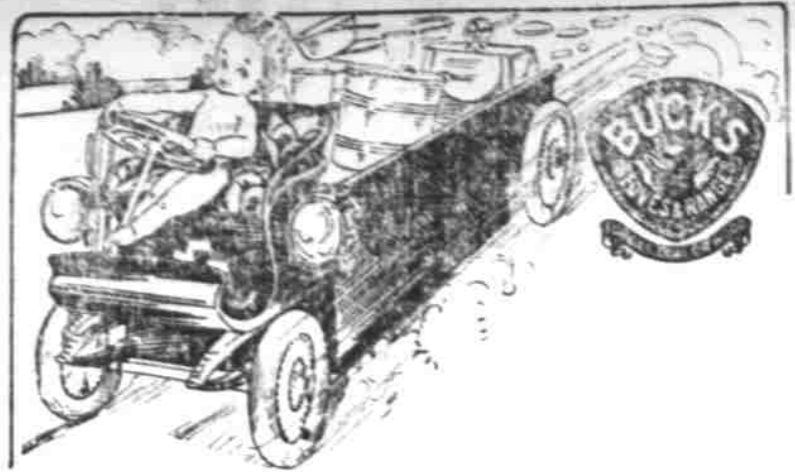
