Many persons are laboring under misinformation in regard to the proposed new road legis lation for Caldwell county and we suggest to them to investigate the matter thoroughly as it is the most important measure that is before the county at this time. Quoting the late Presi dent Grover Cleveland, "It is a condititon, not a theory that confronts us" Caldwell is loosing good citizens every year because of bad roads and other inconveniences and the question is shall we let this drain continue, or make an effort to check it as well as provide modern comforts for ourselves.

We notice that the legislature has not yet made any effort to protect the people and sheep of the state from the ravages of worthless dogs. One death from hydrophobia costs the state more in real loss than every dog in the state is worth, to say nothing of the continued de struction of sheep and other property.

Now if you favor good roads, call on the Vice President of for 15 weeks work and \$100, per your township and give him your name as a member of the Good Roads Association of the county. The object of the Association is to work for better roads and whether a bond issue is voted or not, united effort on the part of our people will help the roads of the county in many ways. So see your committee or township vice. President and enlist in the good work.

We find the sentiment in favor of the county commissioners making a sample piece of road, is growing. It'is argued that a sample or several of them made on different roads would be the best possible way to show to the people what a modern sand clay road is and at the same time find out if the materials available in this county are such as are needed for first class road making. The idea is a good one and can do no harm while it might save the county much expense should LENOIR the bond issue be voted, by test ing the materials we have in this county.

With four more judges in the state and four more districts the gentlemen will have more time to loaf on their jobs by the longer division of the work, if they should choose to do so and no doubt many of them will.




