THE NORTH CAROLINA LEGIS-LATURE. [Condensed from the News.]

SENATE. WEDNESDAY, Jap. 21st. 1873. Senate called to order at 11 o'clock. Lieut. Governor Brogden in the chair. The chair appointed as select committee to prepare and report a revision

of the incorporation laws, chapter 199, of 1871 and '72, Messrs Murphey, Norwood, Merrimon, Grandy and Harris. Message from the House transmitting a message from the Governor concerning the sale of the Western North Carotina Railroad. Referre 1 to Joint Select committee on the sale of the said Road.

Mr Seymour, a bill to amend chapter 185, acts of 1869 '70. Referred. Mr Morehead, of Guilford, a bill to prevent destruction of timber, making it a misdemeanor for persons to disturb timber upon another person's land .-Referred.

Mr Nicholson, a bill to allow certain real estate to be redeemed within twelve months after being sold. Referring to schools, churches, &c. Referred. Mr Cunningham moved that the special order for the protection of life and property upon railroads be placed upon

calendar. Adopted. Mr Stilley, a resolution relating to assets of the Board of Education .-Adopted.

The bill relating to the Neuse River Ferry Company, was taken up. Thie bill restricts the charges of said company. Passed its third reading by 29

passed its several readings, after undergoing some amendment. The bill to amend the school law of February 12th, 1872, being the special order for this hour (1 p. m.) its consideration was gone into. On motion of Mr Brown, of David-

son, the bill was considered by sections. Pending definite action the House adjourned.


