

BY THE GOVERNOR. WHEREAS, Official information has been received at this Department that FRANK MALPASS, late of the county of New Hanover, stands charged with the marder of Edward J. Walker of said county; and that the said Malpass has fled the State, or so conceals himself that the ordinary process of law cannot be served upon him:


