FXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT, STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA RALEIGH, Sept. 23, 1873.) PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Official information has been received at this Department that FRANK MALPASS, late of the county of New Han-over, stands charged with the murder of Edward J. Walker of said county; and that the said Malpass has fled the State, or so conceals himself that the ordinary process of law cannot be served upon him:

Now, therefore, I, Tod R. Caldwell,
Governor of the State of North Carolina, by virtue of authority in me vested by law, do issue this my Proclamation offering a reward of THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS for the arrest and delivery of the said Frank Malpass to the Sheriff of New Hanover County, in the City of Wilmington, and I do enjoin all officers of the law and all good citizens of the State to aid in bringing said criminal to justice.




