### TEMPERANCE.

AT the Temperance Convention, held at Raleigh, on the 15th of December, 1850, it was Resolved that the several Temperance Societies already formed, and those which may hereafter be formed within this State, be requested to become auxiliary to the State Society, and report to its Secretary, the officers and number of members; and also to forward a copy of their constitution to this society. Also that the Secretary of this society report the information to the Parent Society. And as the annual meeting of the North Carolina State Temperance Society will take place on Thursday, the 15th of December next, in Raleigh, the attention of auxiliaries is politely called to the above resolution. A speedy compliance with its request is solicited.

As frequent inquiries are made as to the terms required of auxiliaries, it may serve a good purpose to answer them publicly.

1st. Any society whose members neither make, buy, use, nor sell ardent spirits, except as medicine, may become auxiliary, by sending a copy of their constitution and their reports to the Parent Society through the hands of their Corresponding Secretary, Rev. Thos. P. Hunt, Wilmington.

2d. It is expected of auxiliaries that they report to the Corresponding Secretary annually (a few weeks at least before the annual meeting at Raleigh) their officers, number of members, and any other interesting matter which in their judgment will promote the cause of temperance; and that they send delegates to the annual meeting.

3d. As the society has no funds, and the Secretary serves without any compensation, it is desirable that all communications be post paid.
