THE LEGISLATURE.  
The Legislature adjourned sine die on the 9th...  
instant, after a session of fifty-three days. We...  
omit our Legislative Summary for the last week...  
and in place of it, give the Captions of the Acts...  
passed during the session, which, we have no...  
doubt, will be more acceptable to our readers.  
After reading the Captions, with the explan...  
ations, we think our readers will coincide with...  
us in the opinion, that this session has been fruit...  
ful of much good to the State. Many acts have...  
been passed, which, in our limited judgment, will...  
prove of great benefit to the people; but time alone...  
can test them.  
The bill for submitting the question of "Pen...  
itentiary" or "No Penitentiary" to the people at...  
the August election in 1846, has been passed into...  
a law, and may be put down as the most impor...  
tant act of the session. We have but little doubt...  
that a large majority will be found to favor it...  
We intend publishing in our next, or at some ear...  
ly period, the title reports or the committee's...  
Senate which accompanied the bill.  
The bill appropriating \$5,000 annually for the...  
relief of the Blind, and Deaf and Dumb, we look...  
upon as next in importance. This provision, at...  
present, is amply sufficient, and we hope some...  
judicious plan for their education will be put into...  
immediate operation.  
The bill in favor of Poor Debtors, and the bill...  
more effectually to prevent imprisonment for debt...  
we are inclined to look upon with favor, and we...  
hope, that in their operation they will accomplish...  
the humane intentions of those who enacted them.  
The action of the Legislature in regard to the...  
Rail Road, we believe, was the best that could...  
have been taken under the circumstances. We...  
regret the necessity which demanded the foreclo...  
sure of the mortgage on the Raleigh and Gaston...  
Road; but we do not see how any other measure...  
could have been adopted, in justice to the State...  
that would have been more to the benefit of the...  
stockholders.  
We are too much crowded for space to notice...  
other Acts of the Legislature which we regard as...  
important; but our readers are referred to the...  
Captions themselves, and can form their own...  
opinions. We repeat, the Legislature has done well;...  
and though there may be some omissions, there is but...  
little, in our opinion, to censure.  
The Protest.—On the Saturday preceding...  
the adjournment of the Legislature, Mr. Biggs...  
presented a long printed paper, which he called a...  
protest, signed by the Locofoco Senators, and de...  
manded that it be spread upon the journals of the...  
Senate. The constitution secures to the members...  
of both Houses of the Legislature the right to...  
protest, and to have the reasons entered upon the...  
journal; but this paper contained not simply the...  
reasons of the protest, but was a one-sided argu...  
ment in favor of Emmett, and contained palpable...  
and gross misrepresentations and mis-statements...  
of facts and testimony, and charged the...  
committee of the Senate with insincerity and...  
duplicitv in the case of Emmett, the Speaker with...  
improper conduct, and the Senate with convicting an...  
innocent man of a foul crime by a party vote. Of...  
course the Whig Senators voted against spread...  
ing such a paper on the journals, and as the...  
Locofoco Senators retired in a body without the...  
bar, and refused to vote, it was not put upon the...  
records. When we have more room we may, per...  
haps, again refer to the subject.

the best of order. While eating, some...  
spoke of the manner of eating our barbe...  
cue, and compared it to that of the com...  
mon soldier; others thought it was equal...  
if not superior to Gen. Jackson's own...  
table while in camp. After eating sumptu...  
ously, the company was again formed in...  
double file, marched to the ground on...  
which they were to assemble, where the...  
president of the day stepped in their front...  
and addressed the company in something...  
like the following manner: We have as...  
sembled and have celebrated the day with...  
that degree of respect due such an occa...  
sion. Nothing has occurred, as I hope...  
to mar the feelings of any one; all has...  
been union, concord, and social peace.  
And when we depart from this place, let...  
each one consider that he has performed...  
a duty he owes to himself and his...  
country. Therefore let us go home to our...  
wives and our fire-sides to enjoy that...  
liberty which was purchased for us by the...  
blood of the Revolution. The marshal...  
then dismissed the company after a few...  
guns had been fired, and they broke up...  
in quite a becoming manner.
